Draft Minutes of the Meeting

Attendance

The sixteenth meeting of the Ad Hoc Faculty Senate GAI Committee convened at 1:31 p.m. on October 16, 2025, in Room 135F of Thomas Boyd Hall at the LSU campus, with the Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary being present. No public comments were offered.

Lee made a motion to approve the minutes from the previous meeting on October 9, 2025. The motion was moved and unanimously approved.

For Chair's Update, Singh reported that the State Governor's Executive Order on AI has been enacted, the Louisiana Board of Regents issued related guidelines, and the ITS AI policy has been approved by the Faculty Senate (FS) IT Committee. The FS Ad Hoc GAI Committee is now responsible for completing final guidelines. Discussion focused on the ITS AI policy (PS-121-ST-4). Committee members recommended removing the AI definition for consistency, noted restrictions on freeware and opensource tools under the Executive Order, and agreed that Section B.3 should state "recommending" instead of "making" decisions. Questions were raised about software compliance (e.g., MikeGPT), document revisability, and faculty support resources, and the discussion continued.

Under Unfinished Business, the Committee continued working on the Curriculum Guideline document led by Lee. Some members of the Committee raised concerns about defining the scope of "AI" versus "Generative AI." The Committee agreed that Tyagi would add an introductory paragraph specifying that this Guideline document addresses Generative AI, excluding Machine Learning and other AI systems. Committee members also proposed refining several unclear sentences.

The meeting adjourned at 2:55 p.m.
